Nestled in the beautiful village of Hutton-le-Hole, in the North York Moors National Park, **Ryedale Folk Museum** is Yorkshire's leading open-air museum.

It is the only museum telling the story of the people of the North York Moors, with 20 heritage buildings – some rescued from around the area – beautifully displayed over a 6-acre site. Together with more than 40,000 objects and antiques they bring to life the history and lives of ordinary people from Ryedale.

Step back in time and explore...

- A typical **Iron Age roundhouse**
- A **Medieval crofter's cottage**
- A thatched **Elizabethan Manor House**
- An **18th Century thatched cottage** complete with rare wooden witch post
- A **Victorian thatched cottage**, washhouse and dairy and an array of horse-drawn vehicles – a hearse, fire engine, carriages and ploughs
- **Traditional workshops** of the blacksmith, cobbler, wheelwright, finsmith, cooper, saddler and carpenter
- An **Edwardian daylight photographic studio** – the oldest in the country
- **Vintage farming equipment** – tractors, ploughs, carts and threshing machine
- A nostalgic **1950s village shop and chemist**



Outside there are pretty cottage and kitchen gardens, with old varieties of flowers, herbs and vegetables grown the way they used to be; a traditionally managed cornfield with over 40 species of flowers; and an orchard and farming area with rare breed pigs, sheep and chickens.
